

Admission to Switzerland County High School From Private or Home Schools

The following policy will be followed before a student from a private or home school will be allowed to enroll in Switzerland County High School:

1. Credits from private or home schools will be accepted at face value if the private school is commissioned by the Commission on General Education of the State of Indiana.
2. Credits from non-accredited private or home schools will not be accepted at face value. The Superintendent may require a battery of tests to determine grade placement, or he shall require evidence of credit equivalency with the approval of the Board of School Trustees. The evidence of equivalency may include an evaluation of teachers' licenses, a course of study from the private or home school, and results of nationally normal standardized achievement test.
3. The final decision regarding matters of student grade placement will be the responsibility of the public school officials and Board of School Trustees.
